Here are our observations: -

Food Provision.

1. Might be better to serve all the food in the large room, keeping it round the edges
2. Put tables and chairs in the centre - I realise that loose chairs are a health and safety issue, but there was a big shortage of chairs, including in the tea and coffee area.
3. Remove all stalls from the large room to other areas
4. The widest choice of food was being served at the bottom of the stairs, causing severe congestion. Visitors were trying to buy food, carry it away, go up or down the stairs, go in or out of the narrow doors into the large room.

It must be a nightmare for food suppliers to estimate the amount of food required - potentially they could have unsold food, or a loss of sales by providing too little.
